➔ **NOTE: Sign Language** - As you are teaching the lessons each week, remember to sign the words you have learned as you come across them. This will reinforce each sign to the Kiddoz. The signs you have learned are printed in ***bold italics*** throughout the lesson to help you remember.



Teach the kids the sign language for **GOD** and practice with them while asking them to also say, "God". Practice a few times, and then tell the Kiddoz you have something so very special to tell them about God.



Show them the sign language for **CREATE** while asking them to say, "Create". The word "create" means to make. SAY: God ***created*** you – He made you, but long before God made you, He ***created*** the world.

PROP: Show an inflatable globe.

SAY: In the very beginning, **God** made the heavens and the earth. He made day and night; he made the water and the sky; He also made the sun, the moon and the stars. **God created** the world for His glory and also for us to live in and enjoy.

PROP: Show the kids real images of the earth, the sun and moon, the sky, etc....



Show them the sign language for **THANK YOU** and have them practice.

Ask them to pray with you:

PRAYER: *Thank You, God, for creating the world, and thank You, God, for creating me. Amen.*
